Applicant must have been an active member of one of the Lexington County FF A chapters for two years.

Applicant must be pursuing a career in Horticulture, Agriculture or a related field.

Recipients must plan to attend and be accepted by an accredited four-year college/university or accredited technical college that is located in South Carolina.

Scholarship is for the first year of college only and is not renewable.

The Iris Garden Club determines the number of scholarships awarded annually and the amount of each scholarship.

The Iris Garden Club shall review all applications and shall have full authority to grant scholarships.
