Purpose and Eligibility Requirements:

This scholarship is provided by the Lexington District One Educational Office Professionals Organization and will be awarded to a current Lexington School District One student meeting the following qualifications:

1. Is a graduating senior who plans to attend an accredited two or four year institution in the fall term following the awarding of the scholarship.
2. Is pursuing a degree in a Business program (Computer Science, Advertising, Marketing, Accounting, etc.).
3. Has maintained a 3.0 GPA in high school.
4. Is a United States citizen and a resident of South Carolina.
5. Demonstrates commitment to the business profession through grades and character.

Guidelines:

Applications must be typed or printed legibly. To be considered complete, all applicants must submit a three-page application (includes the written response to two essay questions) and three recommendations.

A panel of committee members will select one winner from all applications received. The criteria for selection are based on financial need (30%) scholastic achievement (20%), recommendations (20%), written response (20%), and extracurricular activities (10%). The decision of the committee will be final. A winner will be announced by the Scholarship Committee in April and notified by letter. Funds will be distributed to the educational facility designated by the scholarship winner upon verification of registration. The check will be written to both the scholarship winner and the educational facility.

Applications should be signed, dated, and returned to the Counseling Department of Lexington Technology Center, Lexington High School, Gilbert High School, Pelion High School, White Knoll High School or River Bluff High School.
